

WHAT IS THE G.S.S. ?

The Guild of Servants of the Sanctuary is a Guild of Altar Servers which seeks to deepen the spiritual life of its members and to help them to become more worthy of their high office. It is entirely a society of lay people but welcomes Bishops, Priests and Deacons as Associate Members.

Altar Servers from many parishes meet at their Chapter and Festivals for Worship and Fellowship, often providing support for servers who may be the solitary server at their church.

There are Chapters throughout England, Wales and overseas.

The Council, while cordially welcoming the interest and support of Priests in the work of The Guild, is anxious that the connection with it should not be merely formal and asks that Priest-Associates shall undertake to remember The Guild in their prayers, and in particular, to plead the Holy Sacrifice on behalf of the work of The Guild at least once a year, if possible at the time of the Annual General Meeting of The Guild on the Saturday in Easter Week.

The Council further asks for the assistance of Priest-Associates in promoting the Objects of The Guild as set forth in the Guild Manual, among the servers who under their influence, and where possible, to support the 'Candidates for Ordination Fund'.
