The trustees thought it fitting that the interest from the fund be used to assist churches where servers are in need of new robes and there is a connection with the Guild.

CONDITIONS OF ANY GRANT

1. A grant up to 50 % of the cost of the purchase may be applied for (maximum of £250).
2. An interval of 2 years must elapse between applications.
3. Copy of Receipts for purchase for cassocks etc will be required at the time of the application.
4. The items will belong to the church – not to individuals
5. Approval of grants will be at the discretion of the Trustees.
